

MEMORANDUM FOR Commanders, Directors and Office Chiefs of Team WSMR

SUBJECT: Policy Letter #12: Safety Policy

1. Our Safety and Health program is focused on a safe and healthy workplace for all. Awareness and close attention to safety and health matters must always be foremost in our minds and demonstrated by our actions. It is also essential to the accomplishment of our mission and the health and well being of our community. Safety can only be accomplished when fully embraced by all.
2. Army leadership at all levels are committed to the safety of our people and protection of our assets. As the Commanding General of White Sands Missile Range and the Chief Safety Officer, I expect every activity to be carried out, keeping safety paramount in planning and execution.
3. I expect commanders, directors, managers, and supervisors to promote safety in every activity. I expect that a complete composite risk assessment of each activity is performed and potential hazards are identified and mitigated. If hazards cannot be mitigated to acceptable levels of risk, we must focus on alternatives that will allow us to complete our tasks.
4. I expect all to extend safety beyond your workplace and to your everyday lives. You are our biggest asset. The high technology systems and facilities that we possess here at WSMR are worth nothing without you.
5. This policy will be disseminated to all employees and a copy posted on all official bulletin boards.
