This agreement may be terminated or modified by the Commander, White Sands Missile Range and the Commander, William Beaumont Army Medical Center (with the concurrence of the Civilian Personnel Director at the Command level, at which the agreement is approved) for reasons which are in the best interests of the Army by issuing a written notice to that effect.
- c. The Co-op Warrior, or the activity on behalf of the Co-op Warrior, may request in writing release from provisions of the agreement through command channels in the event that subsequent circumstances become such that undue hardships or gross inequity would result if release were not granted.
